FIRE CONTROL 1

8-HOURS

This program introduces new firefighters to fire behavior and development as well as water application principles in order to effectively extinguish Class A fires. This program provides firefighters with skills necessary to function as the nozzle operator of an interior fire attack team. Firefighters will work in a variety of fire situations utilizing direct, indirect and combination water application techniques. This curriculum meets WAC 296-305-05501 (2) and NFPA 1001 Fire Fighter I performance requirements.

- PREREQUISITES:** Meet requirements of NFPA 1001 Level 1 - Firefighter I
