COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT



FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS I (PFE)

8- Hours

This course will supplement a firefighter's knowledge of basic hose handling, firefighting equipment, portable fire extinguishers and extinguishing agents. It introduces the attacks and procedures required to safely control and extinguish flammable fuel fires, covering properties, and behavior of flammable liquids in bulk, fire extinguishing agents, safety, tactics, communications, and environmental concerns. The six hour application session includes fireground, experience on selected props. Students will participate in field exercises utilizing specially designed mock-ups of automobiles burning at a street curb and portable extinguisher props. This curriculum meets WAC 296-305-05502, and NFPA 1001 performance requirements for Firefighter II level certifications.

- PREREQUISITES:** Sponsored by Fire Service Agency and/or enrolled in fire service educational program or course of study.
- CLASS DATES:** March 21, 2015
- CLASS TIME:** 0800 – 1730 hours
- CLASS SIZE:** Class size is limited to 24 candidates; a minimum of 12 candidates.
- LOCATION:** Washington State Fire Training Academy, North Bend, WA

- WHAT TO BRING:** SCBA with spare cylinder
